The City of Wilsonville, operator of the South Metro Area Regional Transit (SMART) agency, is pleased to provide this letter of support for TriMet's application to the Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund (STIF) Discretionary Grant program to fund a proposed Regional Express/Limited Stop Bus Network Study.

The study is the first step towards the creation of strategy for implementing Express/Limited Stop and Bus on Shoulder service in the greater Portland metropolitan region. Reducing congestion and improving transit service are important aspects of the City of Wilsonville's Transportation Systems Plan (TSP) and SMART's Transit Master Plan (TMPP), and TriMet's proposed project advances these goals.

We are excited about the process of identifying, evaluating and eventually implementing Express Bus / Limited Stop and Bus on Shoulder services in the Wilsonville area. As regional partners in this project Wilsonville and SMART will provide staff time and information resources to support the work of the project Technical Advisory Committee.
