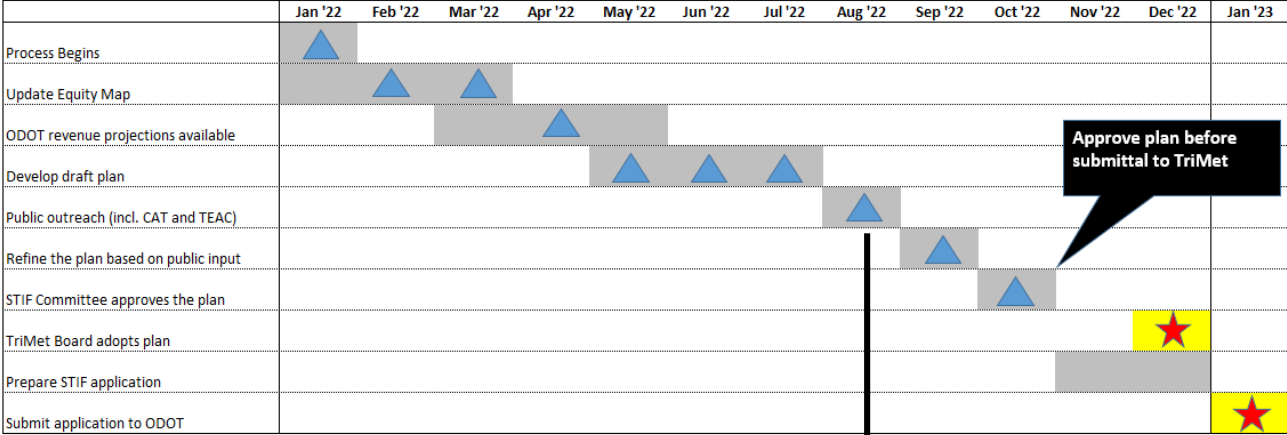

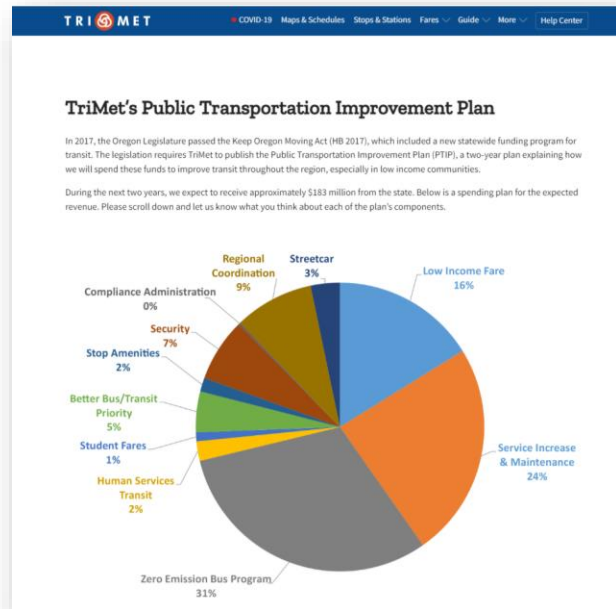

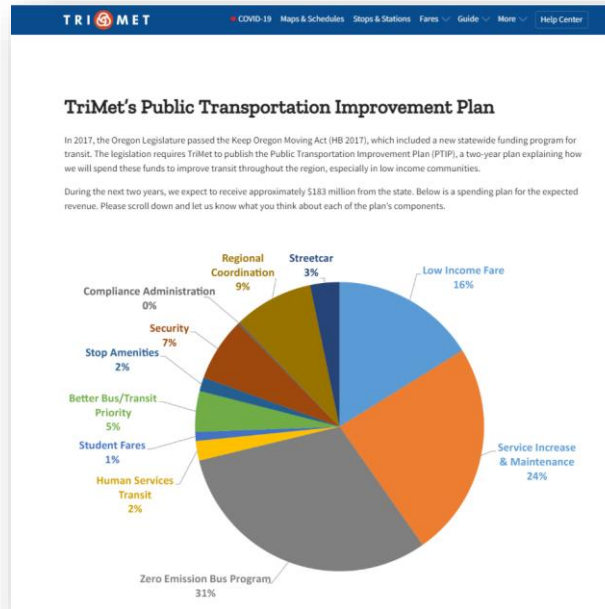

STF Background and History

- Established in 1985 in support of transportation services for seniors and people with disabilities.
- Funds are distributed to 42 designated agencies based on population: Cities, Counties, Transportation districts, Public or private agencies and Indian Tribes.
- Designed to be flexible, coordinated, reliable, and continuing source of revenue originally funded with cigarette tax, ID card revenue, other funds as directed.

STF Purpose and Intent

- Provides transportation services to access health, education, work and social/recreation opportunities to support independent living
- Emphasizes services for seniors and people with disabilities of any age
- All trip types: to healthcare, education, work and social/recreation opportunities to support independent living



STF & STIF Comparison

▪ STF

- Flexible, coordinated, reliable, and Continuing source of revenue
- All trip types: to healthcare, education, work and social/recreation opportunities to support independent living
- Emphasizes services for seniors and People with disabilities of any age

▪ STIF

- Dedicated funding to improve or expand Public transportation
- All trip types
- Emphasizes:
 - Serving low-income households
 - Procuring low or no emission buses
 - Intercommunity connections
 - Coordination between providers
 - Serving high school students

STF Funded Projects

Examples of eligible projects:

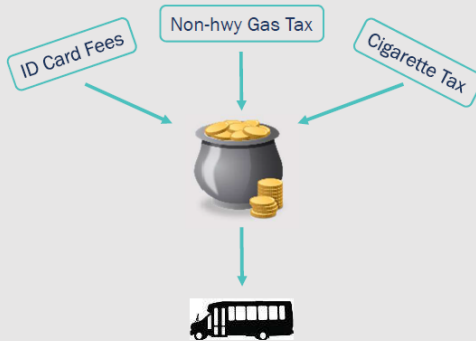
- Match for federal grants for projects that provide service for seniors and people with disabilities
- Dial-a-ride transportation services (curb-to-curb or door-to-door service)
- Taxi and bus ticket subsidy programs
- Travel training
- Purchases of equipment, such as vans, buses and wheelchair lifts



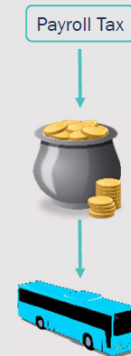

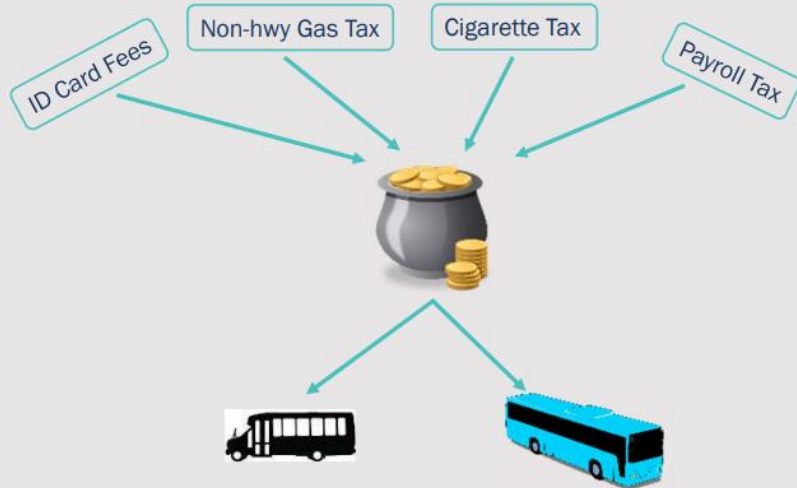

- Share recommendations with the HB2017 Transit Advisory Committee

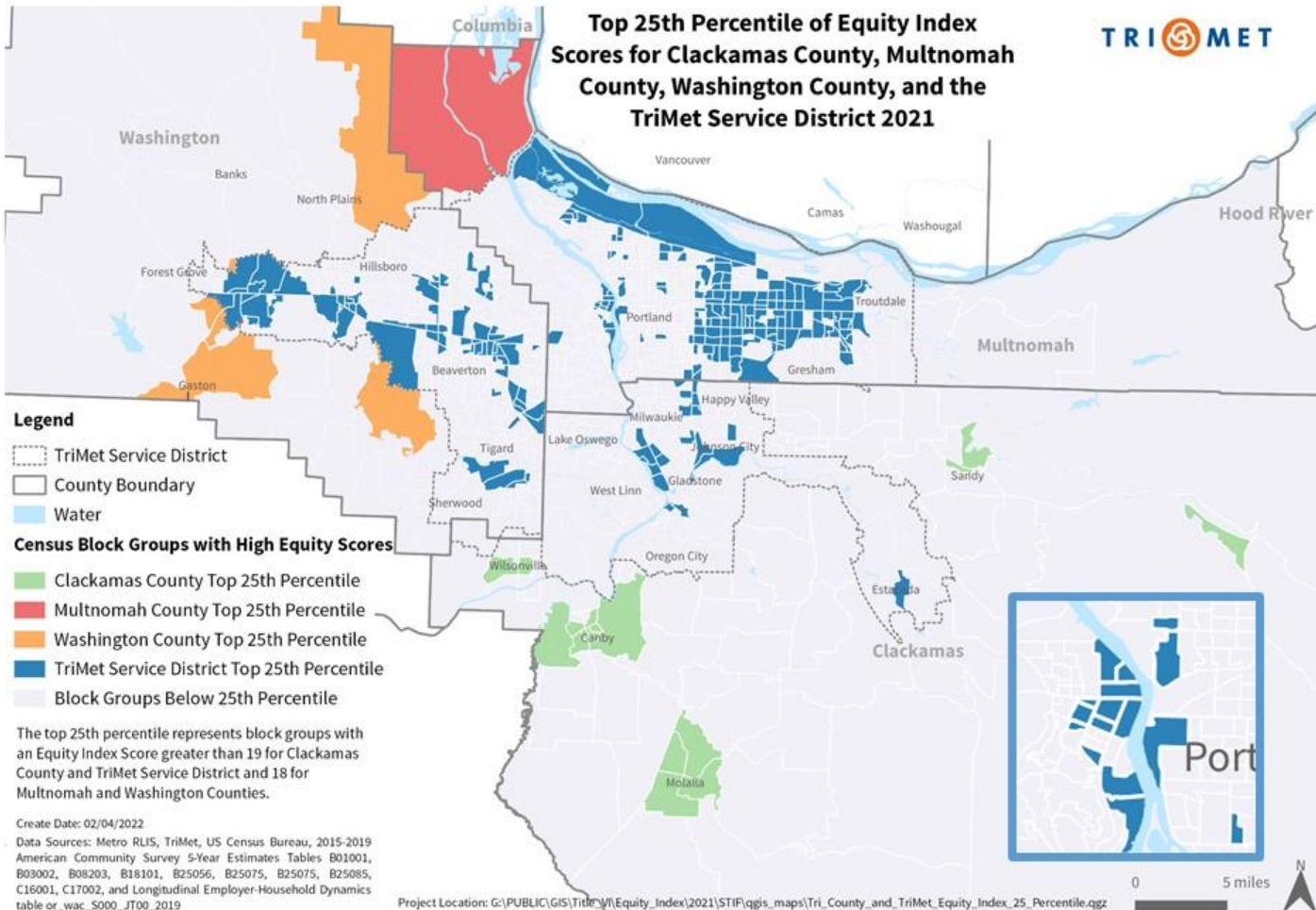
Important STF Dates
